Bus

Getting there and back again without a car is easier than you might imagine!

All Naropa students, faculty and staff receive a **free RTD Eco-Pass** to ride any RTD bus. Arapahoe and Nalanda campuses are on the **Jump** bus line. Paramita campus is on the **Bound** line, reachable via **Jump**. All campuses have a stop right outside their front doors!

- Click on the “*Local Routes and the Community Transit Network*” to choose the route nearest to you.
- Click on the “*Don't know which route to take?*” menu to find the right bus for you and yours.

Bicycle

The Naropa Bike Shack is a student-run organization on the Arapahoe campus open to all Naropa community members from all campuses. At the Bike Shack you can:

- Build-a-bike: learn how to build a bike from the ground up, and keep it when you've finished!
- Borrow bikes: if available, the Bike Shack can give you a bike to use temporarily in exchange for some of your help.
- Get **free** bicycle tune-ups
- Get affordable (and often free) spare parts!

Boulder B-Cycle is a local bike sharing organization. You get **unlimited one-hour trips**. Just check out a bike from any kiosk, and return it to any of the dozens of kiosks located all over Boulder.

A Boulder B-Cycle annual pass is valid for 12 months from the date you sign up and includes:

- **Free rides** on B-Cycles for the first 60 minutes (\$3/ half hour after that)
- **Unlimited** B-Cycle rides 24/7
- Use of B-Cycles in **17 cities** nationwide

Need to drive, but don't want to own a car? Naropa partners with **eGO carshare** to bring easy car-sharing to the Arapahoe and Paramita campuses. Our partnership offers the Naropa community their \$25 registration fee back in driving credit, and hourly rates range from \$4.50-
